

## DON'T MAKE AN OUBLIETTE OUT OF THE DRAIN

## Bath tub

- Rinse the bath well with water after use to remove dirt and soap residue.
- Make it a habit to clean it weekly with hot water and Feem Active Cleaner.
- Let it absorb for a quarter of an hour and rinse well.
- Dry the bath tub completely with a dry microfibre cloth.
- Stubborn lime can be removed the same way with some soapy water and cleaning vinegar.
- Never use abrasives or abrasive sponges to clean the bath, this can damage the surface!

## **Shower**

Just like with the bath tub, the shower must be cleaned regularly. It's best to clean the tap right after showering and go over the walls and shower door with a window wiper. Try cleaning the shower a little every week with some soapy water and Feem Active Cleaner.

<u>Tip</u>: When the tap drips, there can be yellow stains in the bath or shower. Treat these stains with some lemon juice and rinse with cold water.

## How can you unclog the drain in an environment-friendly way?

- Use rubber gloves and take all hairs and soap residue out of the drain.
- Pour a cup of baking soda in the drain and afterwards a cup of vinegar.
- Let this absorb for half an hour.
- Wash out the drain with boiling water afterwards.
