

# DESCALING WITH VINEGAR AND PATIENCE

Scaled shower heads and pipes, lime scale on taps and several household appliances... We all have seen the problem more than once. This lime is present in our tap water and the lime scale is caused by the hardness of the water.

Feem Active Cleaner can be used for all purposes on all possible materials. The only thing it doesn't do is descaling: In short: you don't need much more than Feem Active Cleaner and an alternative to a descaling product at home! But what is the easiest way to remove lime scale?

You can do this with the help of the huge supply of descaling products, but that's certainly not the cheapest solution. Moreover, these products are hazardous to the environment. That's why you choose cleaning vinegar. It's just as good and doesn't damage the plumbing and household appliances. Furthermore, it's way better for the environment.

## **Shower heads**

To avoid lime scale on shower heads, we recommend wiping it dry after using it. But you can't always prevent lime scale and sometime you need to descale the shower head. To do this, put the shower head in a bowl of cleaning vinegar and water. When you can't unscrew it, just put it in a plastic bag with 2/3 cleaning vinegar and 1/3 lukewarm water and let it absorb the whole night. Rinse well afterwards and do this monthly to prolong the life expectancy of your shower head.



### **Taps**

When you can take off the tap, let it soak for a night in a bowl of cleaning vinegar. The next day, your tap will be fully descaled. When you can't do this, soak a towel in vinegar and wrap the tap for a few hours. The vinegar can get to the lime very well this way.

#### Water boiler

A water boiler full of lime scale works more slowly and less efficiently. Just put some water and a little bit of cleaning vinegar in your water boiler to descale it. Let the water boiler boil very well two times and rinse the inside.

#### Coffee maker

Your coffee maker should be cleaned regularly as well to make sure the appliance doesn't get clogged because of lime scale. This is fairly easy and we recommend doing it every month at least once. Make sure there's no filter and no coffee leftovers in it. Afterwards fill the appliance with water and a few teaspoons of cleaning vinegar. Let the mixture go through the machine, wait an hour and rinse the coffee maker a few times with water before using it.
